What's New

- Tabbed Browsing – Open multiple web sites in a single browser window and switch between them by clicking the tab (or closing them by clicking the “x” on the tab).
- Instant Search Box – Perform searches from the toolbar.
- Favorites Button – Open the Favorites Center to manage favorites, feeds, and history in one place.
- Research Button – Access reference tools such as a dictionary, thesaurus, encyclopedia, and more.
- Feeds Button – A feed, also known as *RSS feed*, *XML feed*, or *syndicated content*, is web site content that can be automatically delivered to your browser. By subscribing to a feed, you can get updated content, such as breaking news, without having to visit the web site.
- Phishing Filter – Helps protect against phishing attacks, online fraud, and spoofed web sites.
- Zoom Level - Enlarge or reduce text, images, and some controls.

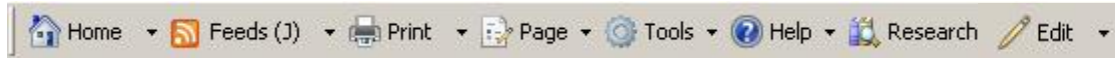
