


How can I make the *Advanced* mode a default?

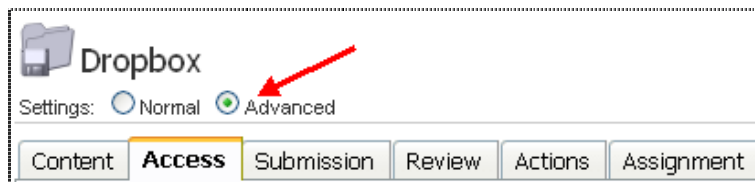

If you work on the settings of course content items (such as a discussion forum, a dropbox, a quiz or dropbox) or the gradebook a lot, you perhaps noticed that the *Advanced* mode gives you many more options than the *Normal* mode would.

You can make ANGEL to stay in the *Advanced* mode by fault so that you don't have to click on it every time. To do so, you would need to:

1. Log on to ANGEL at <http://angel.psu.edu>;
2. Click on the *Preferences* button  on the left of the ANGEL window;
3. Choose **System Setting**;
4. Under *User Level* select **Advanced**;
5. Click on **Save** at the bottom of the page.
